

Who knew that an MGB could practice entropy? Well everyone that owns one I guess. More about that in a bit.

Through the miracle of electronic

Preparing your car for a 4000-mile trip makes you think about all the little maintenance items you have been putting off. Grease in all the right places, topping up fluids in the transmission, rear end and steering rack. Giving everything a good look. That is what owning an MG is about. Always things you can do to your car. You don't need a trip to the local garage so they can use their fancy scanner to tell you what is wrong. Not that you can fix it on a new car anyway.




